This Rotary Global Grant is targeted at raising \$70,000 to provide:

- 1 community bio-sand filtration system for a sector in the community of Trojes, Honduras.
- 263 homes and 1 school will have access to improved water.

Your support of this project will help to significantly improve the health and lives of hundreds of children and their families by providing:

- Sustainable safe water through a community bio sand filter for 263 homes and 1 school, benefiting more than 1,575 people living in the village of Trojes.
- The water system has been improved, but turbidity and contamination continue for these families. The construction of a community bio sand filter will address both of these issues and improve the health of families and their children.
- Additional training for water boards, community leaders and families. The water board, consisting of 7 community members, have received extensive training. The continuation of this project will include education on the bio sand filter, its maintenance and follow up.
